The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is scheduled to begin work on Capitol Dr. (WIS 190) from County F to Brookfield Rd. beginning in late April 2018. Representatives from WisDOT and the Department contractor will be available at the meeting to discuss project plans, schedules, and address any questions or concerns.

Overview:

The \$6.8 million project has been awarded to Payne & Dolan Inc. The project will rehabilitate the 26-year-old asphalt pavement between CTH F and Brookfield Rd. Additional work will include: bridge deck overlays and repairs of the bridges over the Fox River and the eastbound bridge over Duplainville Rd.; turn lane improvements at the intersections of WIS 190 with Springdale Rd. (CTH SR) and Barker Rd. (CTH Y); and replacement of traffic signal equipment, storm sewer, signing, and pavement markings. The construction will require lane closures on Capitol Dr. and short-term closures of Springdale and Barker Rds. at Capitol Dr. Local detours will be posted during intersection closures. Access to all properties will be maintained throughout the project.

Anticipated Project Schedule/Traffic Impacts:

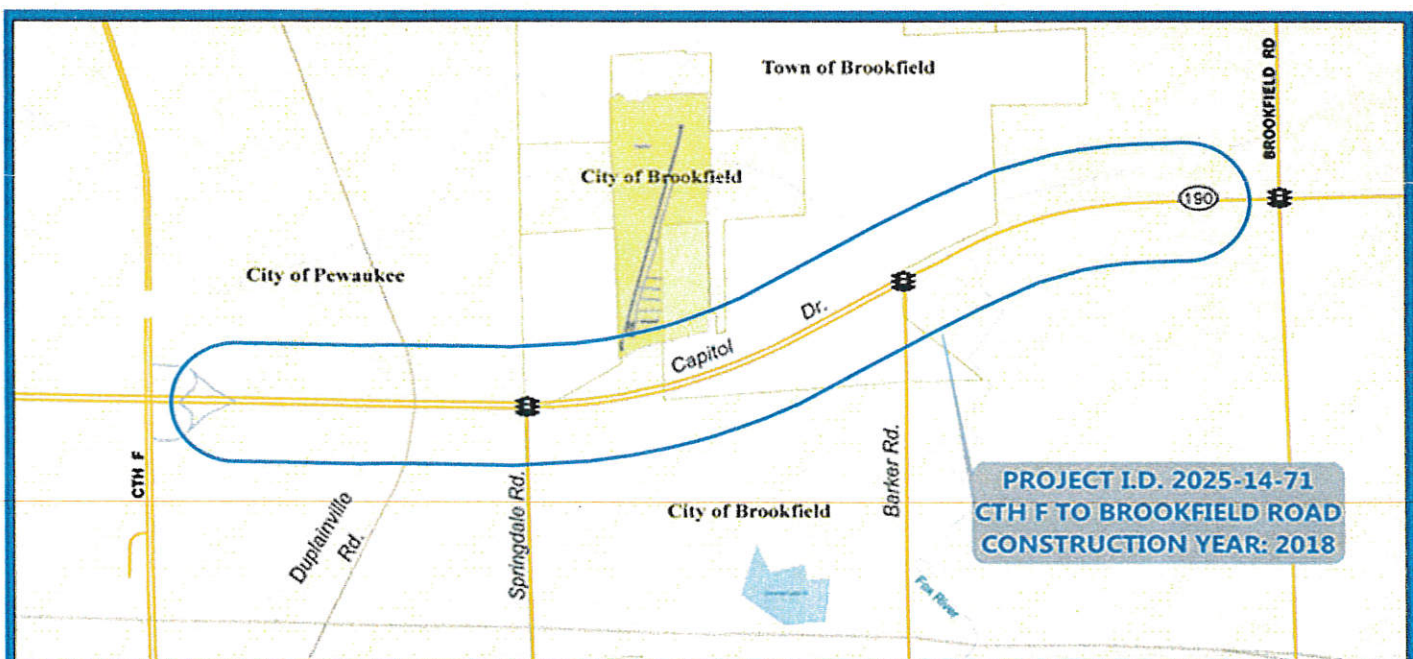
Construction Start – Late April
