

Participant Code of Conduct

The benefits of Parks and Recreation programs are numerous – enhancing quality of life and building strong families and healthy communities. To ensure the quality of programs and public safety, we ask all participants, staff, parents, spectators, coaches and volunteers to abide by the rules set forth by the Park and Recreation Department.

The following rules must be observed while participating in Pewaukee Park & Recreation activities. Specific rules may be added for individual programs and needs.

Act with respect towards others including staff, volunteers and other participants.

Preserve the safety of others. Physical, emotional and verbal abuse is not allowed or tolerated in any of our programs.

Communicate in an appropriate manner. Harsh verbal words, tone of voice, foul language, sexually inappropriate behavior, or gestures will not be tolerated.

Cooperate with or assist the Park and Recreation staff in maintaining safety, order and discipline.

Treat public and private property with respect.

Refrain from using tobacco, alcohol or unauthorized drugs while involved with Park & Recreation program. In addition, refrain from discussing such topics in the presence of Park & Recreation staff, volunteers and other participants.

Follow any additional rules set by the Park & Recreation Department staff or liaisons.

Unacceptable Behaviors include:

Being involved in an instance of any form of insubordination

Harassment or inappropriate or indecent conduct or language

Interference with employee or volunteer duties.

Failure to conform to Park & Recreation Department rules

Use of profanity, vulgar language or obscene gestures

Defacing/damaging Park & Recreation/Public property or the property of others

Engaging in inappropriate physical or verbal contact

Running, pushing, shoving, littering or throwing objects (which are not part of a supervised activity)

Producing loud, rude or unnecessary noises

Involvement or discussion of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, weapons or violence

Disciplinary Action:

The Pewaukee Park & Recreation Department reserves the right to remove participants from any program because of unacceptable behavior. In which cases, a refund **will not** be given. Acts of misbehavior of a violent nature will result in an automatic one (1) year suspension from all Park & Recreation activities or facilities. In addition, if applicable, police assistance will be requested in any occurrences of unlawful behavior.
