We are pleased to announce that the City Recycling Center now accepts leaves and grass clippings. The leaves and grass clippings may be brought to the Recycling Center behind the lower parking lot at City Hall.

If you choose to bag your grass clippings or leaves in plastic bags, the clippings or leaves must be dumped from the plastic bags at the Recycling Center. A barrel is available for disposal of the used plastic bags.

**PLEASE DO NOT THROW LEAF FILLED OR GRASS CLIPPINGS FILLED PLASTIC BAGS INTO OUR RECYCLING PILES OR BINS. WE HAVE HAD OUR YARD WASTE LOADS REJECTED AT THE COMPOSTING FACILITY BECAUSE THE LOAD CONTAINED PLASTIC BAGS. THE RECYCLABLE PAPER BAGS THAT ARE SOLD IN LOCAL HARDWARE STORES ARE ALLOWED IN THE COMPOSTING OPERATIONS.**

We have increased the monitoring of our site so that we can prevent future contaminations.

The following **WILL** be accepted:

- Engine/Motor Oil, filters and antifreeze
- Newspapers – (bundled) and flattened
- Glass bottles and jars – clear amber and green – (washed)
- Brush & small trees (no grass clippings, boards, lumber, stumps or logs over 4" diam.)
- Scrap iron and steel
- Plastic milk bottles (only)
- Corrugated cardboard (only)
- Magazines (bundled)
- Stoves & dishwashers without electrical ballast

The following **WILL NOT** be accepted:

- Garbage
- Trash
- Organic materials

- Tires
- Remodeling or building debris such as tile, plaster, drywall, bricks, concrete block, paneling, studding
- Garden debris
- Brake fluid, chemicals or paint (Contact Waukesha County at 262-896-8012 for proper household hazardous waste disposal)
- Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or dehumidifiers
- TV's, microwave ovens, gas/LP tanks
- Light fixtures

Open Air Burning on the Ground and in a Burning Barrel is allowed BY PERMIT in residential areas only. Permits are issued at the City Hall and are good for one year.

Most accepted recyclables (except oil, trees and appliances) can be picked up at your home along with your regular garbage pickup except for brush. Homeowners can contract with Veolia Environmental Services for pickup of leaves, grass clippings and other yard waste for an additional fee. Call Veolia at 262-367-6040.
