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Ed Shemelya is the National Coordinator of the National Marijuana Initiative, within the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) that is responsible for assisting High Intensity Drug Trafficking (HIDTA) areas nationwide in carrying out the National Drug Control Strategy objectives of disrupting domestic trafficking and production of, and reducing demand for, marijuana and derivative products.
