Play Pewaukee All-Inclusive Playground & Splash Pad Use Policy

The design and intention of the Play Pewaukee All-Inclusive Playground and Garrison's Splash Pad are to serve the Pewaukee community and support Pewaukee Parks and Recreation. Significant Board involvement, staff time and resources were invested throughout the planning, development, construction and outcome of the project.

Recognizing the above, it is essential that these intentions continue now that the park is open. To support this, the regulations below have been created.

Organized group regulations effective 2026:

- Organized groups of 15 or more children and adults are limited to Mondays from 1pm-3pm and must have a pre-paid permit for entrance. Permits can be applied for at the Pewaukee Parks and Recreation Office by completing the 'Pewaukee Sports Complex Organized Group Reservation Form.' Staff may refuse groups that do not have permits attempting to attend the park. (Holidays are excluded from Groups).
- A staff/chaperone to participant ratio of 1:15 or less is required for all parties.
- Only two organized groups (or number of total guests via permit not to exceed 150) will be permitted per Monday (excluding holidays).
- The cost for resident groups (City or Village of Pewaukee) is \$100 per visit.
- The cost for non-resident groups is \$200 per visit.
- Residency is determined by the business address.
- Garrison's Splash Pad will not open when the temperature is not expected to reach 63 degrees Fahrenheit. No refunds will be issued due to low temperatures.
- Permits must be submitted at least two weeks ahead of the requested date. Permit requests less than two weeks ahead of the use date will incur a \$50 late fee.
- Maximum amount of summer reservations per group is three times per season for resident groups and two times per season for non-resident groups.
- Pewaukee Parks and Recreation staff reserve the right to ask a group to leave for failure to follow general park rules, and/or Play Pewaukee Playground and Garrison's Splash Pad rules. Failure to comply with these rules may result in cancellation of current reservations and/or loss of future reservation privileges, with no refunds issued.
- Tables at Play Pewaukee Playground and Garrison's Splash Pad are first-come, first-served.
- The park is open to the general public during organized group reservations.

- It is highly recommended that organized groups using the facility should have a method to easily identify who is part of their group (ex: t-shirts)

FAQ's

1. Are there bathrooms and locker rooms? We have two sets of indoor park bathrooms that can be utilized for changing clothes/swimsuits. We ask that individuals dry off before entering bathrooms. Bathrooms include stalls, urinals, baby-changing stations and sinks.
2. Can we bring a tent? Yes to smaller pop tents no larger than 100' square feet (10x10') and a maximum of three tents per group. Tents must utilize weights, no stakes.
3. Can we bring food or a grill? Yes. All garbage must be disposed of in appropriate locations. Hot coals are not allowed to be disposed on site.
4. Can we reserve the pavilion areas for seating/meals? No – we regularly utilize these areas for summer camp or other programs.
5. Is there bus parking? There will not be specifically identified bus parking, but we recommend towards the corners of the parking lot away from the entrance.
6. Are there any weather-based refunds available? No
7. Fees/charges/security deposits? A card will be held on file to be charged should a group be found leaving behind trash, damage or any other impact to the park causing additional staff labor.
8. Is there a lost and found? No – items found at the park will be left there on a table for a few days before being removed.
